## Strategies for 5\% and 1\% - Answers

1. To find $5 \%$ of a number, divide it by 5 .

This does not work! Try it in the calculator to see that dividing a number by 5 gives a much bigger answer than 5\% of that number. Can you figure out what percent of a number you do get by dividing by 5?
2. To find $5 \%$ of a number, divide it by 10 and then divide it by 2 .

This works! Dividing a number by 10 gives you $10 \%$ of the number. Dividing $10 \%$ by 2 gives you $5 \%$ of the number.
3. To find $5 \%$ of a number, divide it by 2 and then divide it by 10 .

This works! Dividing a number by 2 gives you $50 \%$ of the number. Dividing $50 \%$ by 10 gives you 5\% of the number. Why do you think dividing by 10 and then dividing by 2 gives the same result as dividing by 2 and then dividing by 10? (Drawing pictures may help you think about this.)
4. To find $5 \%$ of a number, find $10 \%$ of the number and then find half of that.

This works! Half of $10 \%$ is $5 \%$. On the grid model with 100 boxes, $5 \%$ is 5 boxes and $10 \%$ is 10 boxes. $5 \%$ is half as many boxes as $10 \%$.
5. To find $5 \%$ of a number, multiply it by 0.5 .

This does not work! Try using a calculator to multiply a number by 0.5 . You will get something much bigger than $5 \%$. Can you figure out what percent of the number you do get?
6. To find $5 \%$ of a number, multiply it by 0.05 .

This works! 0.05 means 5-hundredths. Multiplying a number by 5-hundredths gives you 5-hundredths or $5 \%$ of the number.
7. To find $1 \%$ of a number, divide it by 1 .

This does not work! What happens when you divide a number by 1?
8. To find $1 \%$ of a number, divide it by 100 .

This works! 1\% of a number means 1-hundredth of the number, so you can find it by dividing by 100.
9. To find $1 \%$ of a number, divide it by 10 and then divide it by 10 again.

This works! Dividing a number by 10 gives you 10\% and dividing that by 10 gives you 1\%.
10. To find $1 \%$ of a number, find $10 \%$ and then divide that by 10 .

This works! 1\% is one-tenth of $10 \%$.
11. To find $1 \%$ of a number, multiply it by 0.1 .

This does not work! Try multiplying a number by 0.1. What percent of the number do you get?
12. To find $1 \%$ of a number, multiply it by 0.01

This works! 0.01 means 1-hundredth. Multiplying a number by 1-hundredth gives you 1-hundredth or $1 \%$ of the number.
