Some interesting things to notice:
$25 \%$ of a number is half as much as $50 \%$ of that same number.
$50 \%$ of a number is twice as big as $25 \%$ of that same number.
$25 \%$ of 100 is 25 .
$50 \%$ of 100 is 50 .
$25 \%$ means the same thing as $\frac{1}{4}$ and $50 \%$ means the same thing as $\frac{1}{2}$.
The decimal for $25 \%$ is 0.25 .
The decimal for $50 \%$ is 0.5 or 0.50 .
